General Information

1. Pray for God's blessing on your faithful preparation for these exams.
2. All tests will be given in the instructor's classroom.
3. These exams count a substantial part of the semester grade.
4. Prepare carefully in advance of exams, instead of cramming the night before.
5. Each testing period is 90 minutes in length. Each class is to meet for the entire scheduled time.
6. Students need to bring materials with them to study for upcoming exams when they have completed their current exam. Students will remain in their classroom the entire 90 minutes.
7. Students who do not have a 1st, 4th or 7th hour exam, but would be in study hall, do not have to arrive at school until chapel at 9:30. If students ride the bus to get to school then this is a moot point.
8. Students need to arrive early enough to properly sign in at the office before going to chapel. The doors in the ACE entry will be locked and the only point of entry is the front entrance.
9. Students who do not have a 3rd, 6th or 8th hour exam, but would be in study hall, do not have to remain at school during this last testing period. If they need to ride the bus home then this is a moot point. If students are leaving after their 2nd, 5th, or 7th hour exam, they must sign out in the office.

10. Students who will be riding home with another student must notify the school with whom they are leaving.
11. Once students arrive at Luther High School, they will not be allowed to leave and come back. So, this means students in 2nd or 5th hour study hall will not be allowed to leave campus during study hall and come back to take an exam 3rd or 6th hour. This is purely for safety reasons and knowing where our students are.
- 12. Parents, if guidelines #7, #9, or #10 apply to your child(ren), you must notify the Dean of Student in writing or via email, engejon@luther.k12.wi.us, by Monday, December 17th, that your child(ren) will be arriving for chapel or leaving early. If we do not receive written notice from parents, we will not release students until the end of the scheduled day.**
13. If the instructor is not giving a test they will still meet for alternative assessment, lesson or activity for the entire scheduled testing period.
14. Students may not bring electronic devices, unless directed to do so by an instructor.
15. The school's lunch program will not be serving during semester exams. Students will need to pack a lunch.
16. Students' attire must follow the dress code.
17. Bus departure times during semester exams will be 1:50 PM, except for the last day of exams, when the bus departure time will be 11:45 AM. The afternoon Onalaska bus will pick up only if requested.
18. If weather conditions cause school to be closed on a scheduled exam day, that day's exam schedule will be moved to the next day. For example, if school is canceled on Tuesday, December 18th, 1st-3rd hour exams would be moved to December 19th. Then, 4th-6th hour exams would be moved to December 20th, and 7th & 8th hour exams would be moved to January 3rd.
