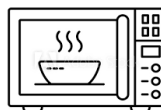
Lunch Tickets

LUTHER BOARD APPROVES FALL SPORTS

At a special Board meeting on August 20, the Luther Board of Control approved all sports to take place in the traditional fall season. At subsequent meetings on Monday, August 24, the Coulee and Scenic Bluffs Conferences also finalized their plans. Coulee Conference schools will be offering tennis, cross country and volleyball in the fall season. They were split on football with about half moving to the spring and half remaining in the fall season. Our new football conference, the Scenic Bluffs, voted to move football to the spring season. The conference completely understands Luther's request to remain in the fall and supported that decision.

The next step is rebuilding the 2020 fall schedules. Most multi-team meets have been cancelled. Modifications will be made to cross country races, tennis matches, volleyball and football games. Watch for more details in the coming days and weeks as these schedules are tweaked in some cases and totally rebuilt in others.

Other changes for this coming fall season include:

- *No conference awards will be given.*
- *Spectators - While a plan has not yet been finalized, it will definitely be limited, with the real potential for no spectators for indoor events, at least to start the year.*
- *Volleyball will play each conference school only once.*
- *Cross Country meets will be limited to conference schools only.*
- *Plans are in the works to have all home volleyball and football games livestreamed.*

Most exciting is that we ARE planning to practice, play and compete! The coaches and administrations from all of the Coulee schools are working diligently to make necessary modifications to get athletes back on the fields, courts and race courses. Our goal has been to do this safely and to not just start the season, but to FINISH the season. Keep all of our athletes, coaches, competitors and spectators in your prayers as we continue to work together to provide a much needed return to activity.

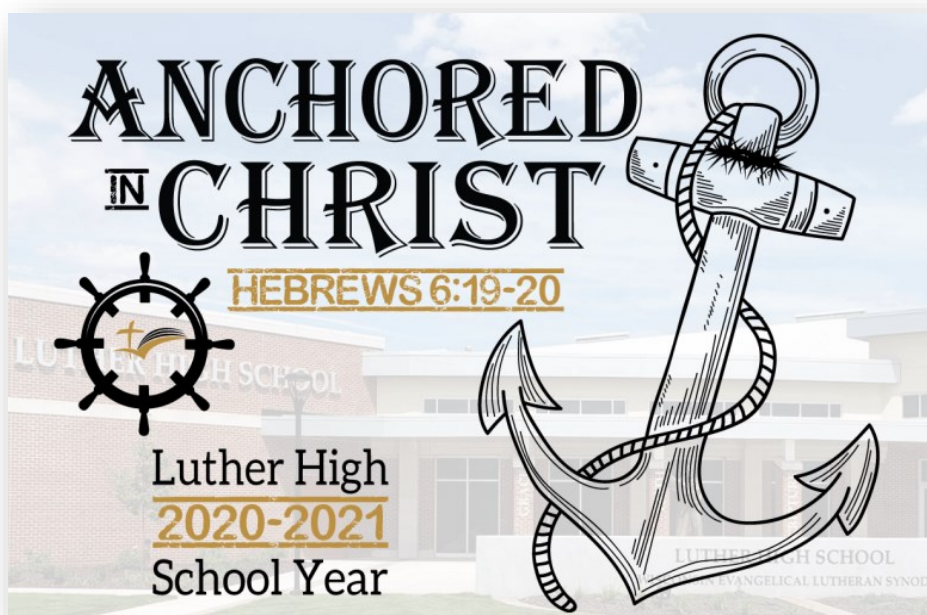
